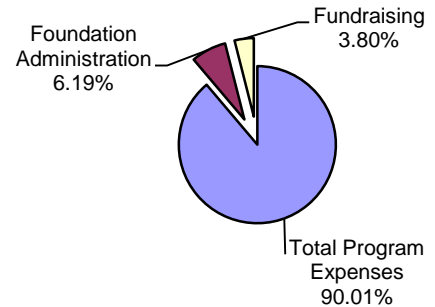

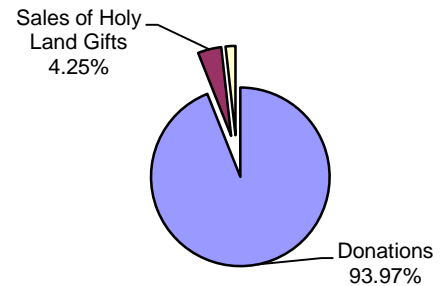

HCEF 2010 Expenses



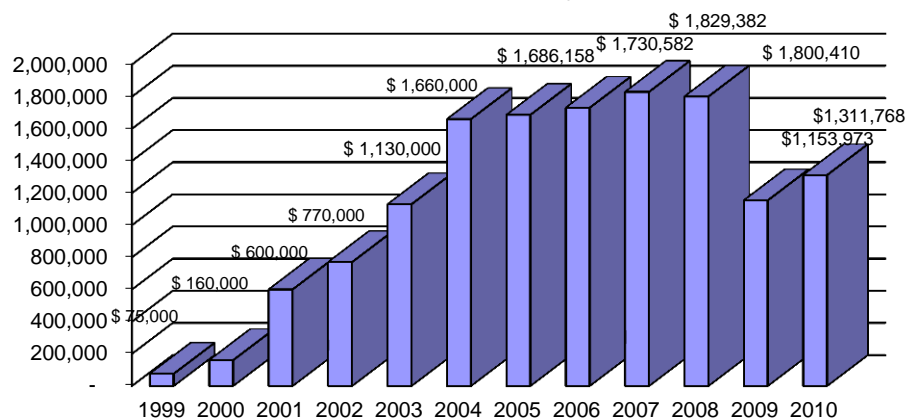
