
## **Monthly Overview**


Birzeit Senior Citizen Center is open 3 days a week (Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday), from 8:00 am to 2:00 pm, offering services to the elderly (BSCC members) 10 days on December. The center organizes social, educational, and spiritual activities, offers health and transportation services, and provides entertainment to local senior citizens. These activities and services **fulfill** the HCEF vision and the mission of the center by providing a safe place for the elderly to come together in community, to know they are honored and not forgotten.

The following statistics offer a glimpse of some of the center's activities in December 2015 as compared to previous months:

## **Services**

#### 1. Transportation Services

The Center provides free transportation services for BSCC members to and from the facility and to and from church on Sundays. The Center also provides transportation for any urgent needs that arise.

#### 2. Nutritious Meals

- ❖ With the support of the World Food Program (WFD) and other local organizations, the BSCC provided hot meals for every day that the Center was open, totaling to 240 hot meals for the month of **December**.
- Snacks such as tea, coffee, milk, biscuits and fruit were also provided to BSCC members each morning that the Center operated, totaling to more than 240 meals.

#### 3. Daily Activities

BSCC members took part in daily games such as bingo, card games, dominoes, and trivia competitions, all of which provide healthy mental stimulation. They also continued working on personal projects, such as knitting and embroidery, and took part in spiritual activities, such as praying and devotionals.

## **Programs & Activities**


#### 1. Spiritual Events

**BSCC** provided 4 main spiritual activities:

- ❖ Daily bible study in which elders read and discuss the bible, extracting lessons for their daily lives.
- Daily Rosary
- ❖ On Wednesday, December 16<sup>th</sup>, 2015 Fr. Louis Hazboun offered Holy Communion to BSCC members and led a group prayer session. During his visit, BSCC elders prayed together for peace in the Holy Land and took Holy Communion.
- ❖ On Wednesday, December 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2015 Fr. Louis Hazboun also offered Holy Communion to BSCC members and led a group prayer session. During his visit, BSCC elders prayed together for the Christmas season to bring peace, love and dignity to humanity.

During his visits, Fr. Louis relates parish news and invites BSCC elders to participate in upcoming parish and community events.





#### 2. Community

As a part of BSCC's effort to encourage Birzeit's elderly to engage in their community, BSCC arranges monthly visits from local organizations, societies and local community members to meet with elders and discuss issues in the community. These exchanges enhance community relationships and give BSCC elders a sense of belonging and importance. Of a recent visit, BSCC elder, Mr. Suheil Shaheen, said: "when we visit our friends and family we keep our social relations alive, and when they visit us at the center we strengthen those relations as they acknowledge our presence. We are still important and remembered". In addition to visits from the community, elders also pay visits to their homebound friends, to whom they minister. After a recent visit, Mrs. Jamileh Aranki noted, "When we visit our brothers and sisters at their home, we feel that the unity and love of Christ is present, it is the spirit of Christianity...our neighbors are our friends, fellow colleagues, and our community." Community building among BSCC elders and beyond creates a sense of purpose that is mutually beneficial to the elders and to the larger Birzeit community.



#### 3. Crafts

BSCC's craft program provides a safe and comfortable environment for Birzeit elderly to pursue and enhance their creative spirit. Through the craft program, members engage in activities such as knitting, preparing traditional Palestinian dishes, and painting. These artistic outlets allow them to express their thoughts and emotions, providing an important and therapeutic activity. Often, their projects depict important memories, reflect spiritual ideas, and help them cope with the passing of friends. As an example of the creative ideas and masterpieces generated by the elders' feelings and commitment, is the "BSCC Olive Tree," a painting that the elders have created depicting BSCC members throughout time. The olive tree is an important symbol of Palestinian culture and heritage.

In the painting, the leafs are inscribed with the names of the living members of the center; with their branches extending into the trunk, rooted deep inside the earth symbolizing their ongoing commitment to their land. Below the olive tree are images of graves depicting the names of fellow BSCC elders who have passed, symbolizing that both living and deceased members remain important to the flourishing of their community. Above the olive tree flies a dove, symbolizing the holy spirit above all, helping the living stones of the Holy Land to have the courage, strength and wisdom to carry on their message of endurance, struggle and hope even during dark times. In the memory of completing 10 years of Service, BSCC Members now have a living heritage of yearly olive tree paintings held in the center to be a memory for generations to come.









#### 4. Health

On Saturday, December 19<sup>th</sup>, a group of nursing students from Ibn Sina Health Sciences school visited the center to conduct health screenings for BSCC members. During the visit, nursing students checked blood pressure, tested for diabetes, and checked the elders' weight, height and vital signs.

#### BSCC Organizes a Community Breakfast for its Elders

On Wednesday, December 9th, 2015, BSCC organized a Christmas community breakfast for local Elders.

Set to the tunes of Christmas songs, the elders enjoyed their breakfast in a warm, loving, and spiritual atmosphere.

Reflecting on the breakfast, Mrs. Georgette Nattour commented: "We enjoyed the breakfast a lot. We felt the warmth of the season. Gathering at one table, sharing bread and food reminded us of the biblical story of Jesus at the Last Supper. It is the warmth of love and sacrifice that is represented in the nativity of Christ. As He said, 'do this in remembrance of me'."

Mr. Fawaz Shaheen agreed and added: "It was really great to experience the real joy of Christmas among all of us. In addition to enjoying the breakfast, I also enjoyed our gathering, praying to the Lord for peace in a united voice. Praying for peace for our country and for our own inner peace. We gathered, laughed and chatted as one caring and loving big family. This is the truly Christmas spirit."

#### BSCC Holds Christmas Tree Lighting Ceremony With The Birzeit Community

On Wednesday, December 16th, 2015, in the presence of Fr. Louis Hazboun, Birzeit Parish Priest, BSCC members and staff lit the Christmas tree in a small ceremony held at the center, with strong attendance from Birzeit university students, civil societies and the local community.

At the beginning of the ceremony Fr. Hazboun blessed the celebration with Holy Mass and offered Holy Communion delivering a simple message of the meaning of Christmas. He also explained the symbols of the Christmas tree and the decorations, "We all came today to celebrate and welcome Jesus Christ. Not only us in this room, but also those who passed away. All the faithful are a unity; the living and the dead".

Mr. Nicola Kawas, BSCC Supervisor, raised a prayer for the Palestinian martyrs and for all those who have fallen victim to terrorism around the world. He thanked the audience for sharing in the happy moments with the elders "... who are our greatest treasure..." and invited all to visit the center on a regular basis hoping that this Christmas season would spark the creation of a New Year's resolution to visit the elders at BSCC and show them how much we love and care about them. At the end of his speech, Mr. Kawas invited us to not only light the Christmas tree physically but to light it in our hearts as well.

Mrs. Ma'zouza Shahin, commented on the celebrations, adding that, for her, it was the best Christmas celebration she has experienced so far, and she truly felt the warmth of Christmas having her own family join her family at BSCC in love and joy.
